## PARENT PAYMENT OPTIONS

Invoices are sent to families in January 2021. Payment for Optional Items including camps and excursions must be paid by the specified due date two weeks prior to departure. Please complete an instalment plan if you wish to set up an arrangement.

### **Preferred Method of Payment**



When school fees are issued for payment, you will see an alert on your dashboard. Click the alert and you will be taken to the Course Confirmation page. You will see any fees requiring payment listed and their status. Click the one you need to action. This will take you into that fee cycle. It will include information from the school, items for payment (some will be mandatory, others voluntary as determined by the school), agreements and some administrative questions. Work your way through the content. At the end you will be required to process the payment. If there is an option to pay via a payment plan, this will display as a payment method.

### Camps, Sports and Excursion Fund (CSEF)

The Camps, Sports and Excursions Fund (CSEF) provides payments for eligible students to attend activities like:

- School camps or trips
- Swimming and school organised sport programs
- Outdoor Education programs
- Excursions and incursions.

In 2021, eligible families will receive \$225 per student, paid onto their family account at Mount Beauty Secondary College.

Applications roll over each year so as long as your health care card is valid, we will automatically be notified of your approval.

To be eligible for CSEF: For new applicants, on the first day of Term 1 or 2, a parent or legal guardian of a student attending Mount Beauty Secondary College must:

- Be an eligible beneficiary within the meaning of the *State Concessions Act 2004*, that is, be a holder of **Veterans Affairs Gold Card** or be an eligible **Centrelink Health Care Card (HCC)** or **Pensioner Concession Card (PCC)** holder, **OR**
- Be a temporary foster parent, and;
- Submit an application to the school by the due date.

Completed forms with a copy of your Centerlink Card, can be collected and submitted to the Mount Beauty Secondary College General Office.
